



GOVERNOR INSLEE: WASHINGTON MUST LEAD THE FIGHT AGAINST CLIMATE CHANGE

You've said before that you could not "in good conscience" support the proposed fracked gas to methanol plant in Kalama. We still need your support and leadership on this issue.

The proposed methanol refinery would be a top polluter in Washington. The refinery would increase current greenhouse gas emissions by a million metric tons a year; increase methanol supply in China, causing more methanol to be burned as fuel; and produce higher worldwide emissions.

Our state has so much at stake if we don't take action to combat climate change. Washington is blanketed in smoke from wildfires. Salmon and orca populations are in decline due to warmer waters, creating imbalance in a fragile ecosystem. The way of life we know in our beautiful state is being threatened by warming global temperatures and industrial pollution.

This multi-decades fossil fuel project has no place in a carbon-free future. Washington must reject all permits for this project. We need your continued leadership on climate; we have too much to lose if this project moves ahead.
